Step Three: Rough Draft

- 1. Write paragraph b, c, d, then a and e.
- 2. Body paragraphs:
 - a. Include a topic sentence for each paragraph.
 - b. Support your topic sentence with quotes and details.
 - c. Explain your quotes and details.
- 3. Introduction
 - a. Start with a hook (story, quote, question)
 - b. Transition from your hook to your thesis so that the paragraph flows
 - c. End with your thesis
- 4. Conclusion

- a. Summarize your ideas in new words
- b. Refer back to your hook

Step Four: Revise

- 1. Add—Does each paragraph has a topic sentence, supporting details, and explanations?
- 2. Rearrange—Is everything in the order that makes most sense?
- 3. Remove—Does it support your thesis? If not, delete it!
- 4. Transitions—do you have transitions between and within paragraphs?
- 5. Citations—Are all quotes and paraphrases properly cited within and at the end of the text?

Step five: Edit

- 6. Capitalize: Is everything capitalized correctly?
- 7. Agreement: Do the subjects and verbs agree? Do you keep the same tense throughout?
- 8. Punctuation: Are sentences punctuated correctly? Are citations punctuated correctly?
- 9. Spelling: Are all words spelled correctly? Check carefully for homophones.
